

This document details the concession types that are eligible for travel discounts on Queensland Rail Travel's long-distance services and available to book on the Agent Portal.

When booking a concession fare, the concession card must always be sighted, and the details entered accurately for validation.

Before accepting and verifying the customer's concession details, please confirm the following details:

- Check the card type aligns with the concession type selected in the rail search process.
- The cardholders first name and last name is added into the booking/profile exactly as per card displays.
- Any listed dependents for Queensland Pensioner entitlement concessions are added using the cardholder's concession number that appears on the pensioner's concession card.
- Each adult must have their own concession card to be eligible for a concession.
- Check the expiry date of the card, it must be a current card.
- Concession numbers are added without spaces or symbols. See the individual guides for formatting below.

Customers booking with a concession card

If one of the passengers travelling holds a concession card and during the rail search you have selected a concession, the concession verification box will appear under the passenger details.

In the passenger details screen, always look up the customer's profile by entering the following details and then click on the Verify button:

- First name
- Last name
- Concession number

Note: It is important that the correct format and accuracy of the concession card information is entered. The cardholder's first name and last name needs to be added exactly as per the card display.

The remaining passenger detail options will auto populate if the results match the database in the customer's profile, and you will receive a Verified Concession successfully message. You will need to complete the mandatory fields if the details are not saved in the database.

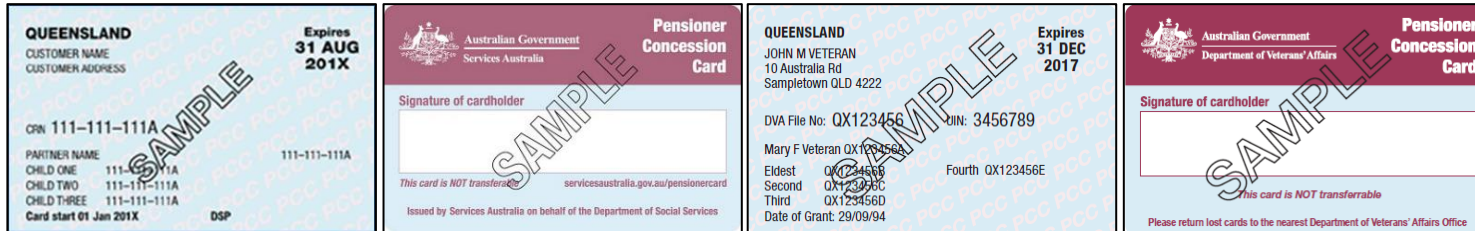
Validating Existing Concession	Process if validation fails
<p>When speaking on the phone to a customer with a validated concession, you must ask for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What type of concession do you hold?• Your concession number?• The State that appears on the card?• Will the card be valid on the day of travel?	<p>Contact us if you need any clarification on validating an existing concession that may no longer be valid.</p>

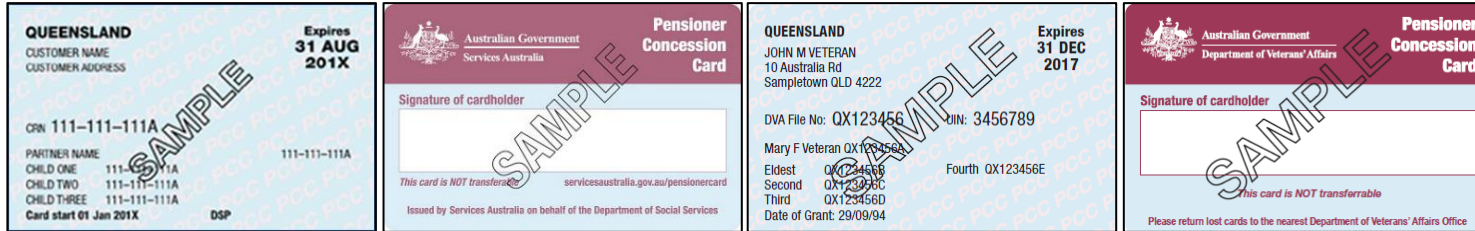

<p>Format to add concession number to Agent Portal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Add the number without CRN or DVA File no. and without spaces or symbols, using a capital letter to match the card. <p>Example 1 On card: CRN 111-111-111A Add in Agent Portal as: 111111111A</p> <p>Example 2 On card: DVA File No. QX123456 Add in Agent Portal as: QX123456</p>	<p>Holders of a current Queensland Pensioner Concession Card issued by Services Australia, or the Department of Veteran Affairs are entitled to four (4) Queensland Pension rail travel entitlements each calendar year.</p> <p>A non-refundable administration fee of \$25.00 per entitlement is payable. Meals and upgrades to sleeping berths and RailBeds are additional costs.</p> <p>A range of eligible customer categories may receive this card including aged pensioners, carers, disability support, single parents, Newstart or Youth Allowance recipients.</p> <p>Registration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Confirm the primary card holder’s given name (first name) and family name (last name) as it appears on the card as well as any listed dependent child names. Check the expiry date. It must be a current card. (Some digital concession cards do not have an expiry date but are still valid to use (e.g. no date but the word EXPIRES shows). The CRN number or DVA file No. is added to the Agent Portal to register the concession to the card holder’s profile. If a 2nd adult is to be registered, they must have their own card.

QLD Pensioner Half fare

Issued by Services Australia or issued by Department of Veteran Affairs

<p>The QLD Pension entitlement concession number is added to this concession for the card holder only.</p> <p>Format as per QLD Pensioner entitlement concession.</p>	<p>A discount of up to 50% off the full adult fare on Queensland Rail Travel long-distance services – unlimited trips.</p> <p>This is in addition to the four (4) travel entitlements available each calendar year. Meals and upgrades to sleepers and RailBeds are additional costs.</p> <p>This concession does not apply to a dependent child travelling with a QLD Pension entitlement cardholder who is using the half fare. Child must be booked as a child and pay the child fare (50% discount).</p>

Format to add concession number	Registration and description of use
<p>As above.</p> <p>The cardholder's CRN is added as the concession number in the Agent Portal for dependent child concessions.</p> <p>Follow the same format as the QLD Pensioner entitlement: no space or symbols and no CRN (e.g. 111111111A).</p>	<p>Children of Queensland Pensioner concession card holders only travel at no additional cost in seats under the following circumstances:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The child must be listed on the Queensland Pension Concession Card (PCC) as a dependent.• The child is travelling (same class, journey, and carriage) with the customer on whose card they are listed.• The primary card holder must travel with them and is utilising a pensioner travel entitlement.• Are attending primary or secondary school.• Children over 16 years of age must still attend secondary school. To confirm secondary school enrolment, evidence is required of QLD Fulltime student with a valid student identification card. <p>All sleeper/RailBeds and meals require additional payment for all those travelling.</p> <p>Add the child's given name (first name) as appears on the Queensland Pensioner concession card and the family name (last name) as provided from the card holder.</p>

(e.g. 987654321) <p>Go Card version is only issued in Queensland.</p>	<p>On presentation of a current Qld Government Seniors Card, customers will receive a discount of up to 50% off the full adult rail fare on Queensland Rail Travel long-distance services.</p> <p>Meals and upgrades to a sleeper or RailBed are not discounted and incur an additional cost.</p> <p>This concession type is not valid for the following types of senior's cards:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Interstate Government Seniors Card Queensland Seniors Business Discount Card Queensland Seniors Carer Business Discount Card National Seniors Australia Card New Zealand Seniors Concession Card <p>Note: If the senior's card doesn't have the card holders name on it then we need to verify the card belongs to that person. 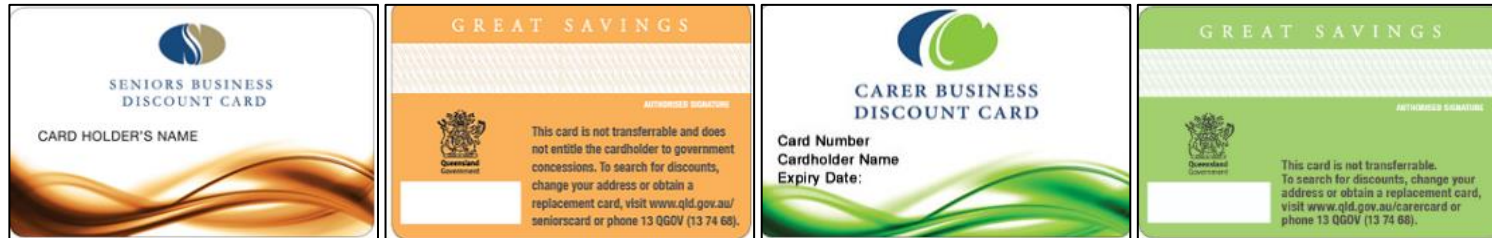

Add the letter if they are included in the card number. (e.g. 987654321 or 177801A)	<p>On presentation of a current Australian State Government Seniors card, customers will receive a discount of up to 50% off the full adult rail fare on Queensland Rail Travel long-distance services when they provide proof of a current Australian state or territory Government Seniors card.</p> <p>Meals and upgrades to a sleeper or RailBed are not discounted and incur an additional cost.</p> <p>This concession type is valid for current senior's cards issued by all Australian states and territories.</p> <p>This concession is not valid for the following types of senior's cards:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Queensland Government Seniors Card• Queensland Seniors Business Discount Card• Queensland Seniors Carer Business Discount Card• National Seniors Australia Card• New Zealand Seniors Concession Card <p>For more information visit Eligible for concessions.</p>

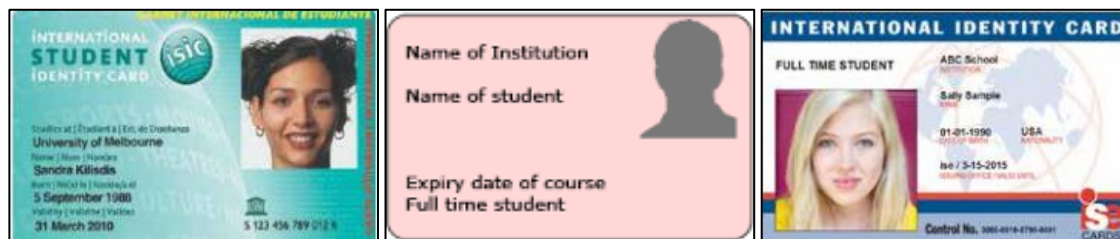

<p>Photo ID is issued in the name of the customer with the permanent disability.</p> <p>The concession type and number are added to the companion or carer's booking and profile.</p> <p>The companion/carers must be travelling with the owner of the Companion Card.</p> <p>Format to add concession number to Agent Portal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Add cardholder's number without any spaces or symbols. <p>Example On card: Q123456789/00 Add as: Q123456789</p>	<p>Queensland Rail Travel's policy allows a carer to travel for free whilst on Queensland Rail Travel long-distance services when accompanying a customer with a disability who requires their assistance.</p> <p>All Australian State Companion cards are accepted.</p> <p>This applies to all classes of travel and includes the applicable berth fees and meals on Spirit of the Outback Sleepers and Spirit of Queensland RailBeds.</p> <p>Carers fare eligibility:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The customer requiring a carer holds a current Companion Card as the card can be used to access carer's fares. or• The customer requiring a carer (using a Queensland Pensioner Rail Entitlement) provides a letter from a doctor which states there is a requirement for a carer to travel with them. <p>For more information on Travelling with a Carer visit Travelling with a Carer.</p> <p>Queensland residents can apply for the card with the Queensland Government via their website or phone 13 QGOV (13 74 68).</p>

<p>A photo pass ID is issued to the card holder and displays the Queensland Government logo or TransLink logo.</p> <p>Format to add concession number to Agent Portal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Add the number excluding the dash and the letters TPI or EDA. <p>Example On card: QX789352-TPI Add as: QX789352</p>	<p>Queensland residents in possession of a Commonwealth Department of Veterans’ Affairs Repatriation Health Card - For All Conditions (Gold), that is embossed with Totally and Permanently Incapacitated (TPI) or Extreme Disability Adjustment (EDA) must hold a TPI or TPI/EDA Veteran Travel Pass to gain access to their entitlements on Queensland Rail Travel services. To apply for this card, see details on the TransLink website.</p> <p>Veterans in possession of a TPI or TPI/EDA Veterans Travel Pass are entitled to one return journey on Queensland Rail Travel long- distance services each fortnight. The travel entitlement covers Business and Economy Seats. Cardholders are required to pay additional charges for sleepers, RailBeds or meals. Travel is only available within Queensland. If the cardholder exceeds their entitlement for the fortnight, they are entitled to half fare travel as often as they wish.</p> <p>Process for 50% rail discount bookings: Please contact us.</p> <p>Spouses/Partners of Queensland TPI/EDA Veteran Travel Pass Holders process:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spouses/Partners of Queensland resident TPI/EDA veterans pass holders who have obtained a confirmation letter from the Department of Veteran’s Affairs are entitled to four (4) annual pensioner rail travel entitlements. The letter is valid for two (2) years from issue. The confirmation letter needs to be emailed to reservations@qr.com.au and we manage adding it to the customer’s profile.

<p>Format to add concession/Travel pass number to rail booking in the Agent Portal:</p> <p>Add the Travel Pass concession number provided in the booking confirmation when purchasing the Travel Pass for each passenger and verify.</p>	<p>For use for holders of a 1-month Queensland Coastal Pass (northbound or southbound).</p> <p>Provides unlimited stopovers in a single direction of travel (i.e., north or south) in economy seats for the 1-month validity of the pass.</p> <p>Free travel on RailBus coach connections booked in conjunction with a rail sector (for Hervey Bay and Airlie Beach).</p> <p>Upgrades apply for travel in Business Seats, RailBeds or sleepers.</p> <p>Advice to Customers They must have a copy of the travel pass and evidence of their non-Australian residency with them when travelling and must be able to show it to the onboard team and Authorised Officers on request. Proof of residency should include for example an international passport supported by a second document verifying international residency details or return air tickets.</p> <p>Terms and conditions are available on our International visitors – Rail fares and travel passes webpage.</p>

Travel Pass Qld Explorer (Travel Pass Qld Explorer 1 month or Travel Pass Qld Explorer 2 month)

<p>Format to add concession/Travel pass number to rail booking in the Agent Portal:</p> <p>Add the Travel Pass concession number provided in the booking confirmation when purchasing the Travel Pass for each passenger and verify.</p>	<p>For use for holders of a 1-or 2-month Queensland Explorer Pass.</p> <p>Provides unlimited stopovers in any direction of travel in economy seats for the 1- or 2-month validity of the pass. Backtracking is allowed.</p> <p>Queensland Explorer passes must not be used to travel between two stations more than twice. These passes are intended for visiting multiple Queensland destinations.</p> <p>Free travel on RailBus coach connections booked in conjunction with a rail sector (for Hervey Bay, Airlie Beach, Winton, Quilpie, and Cunnamulla).</p> <p>Upgrades apply for travel in Business Seats, RailBeds or sleepers.</p> <p>Advice to Customers They must have a copy of the travel pass and evidence of their non-Australian residency with them when travelling and must be able to show it to the onboard team and Authorised Officers on request.
